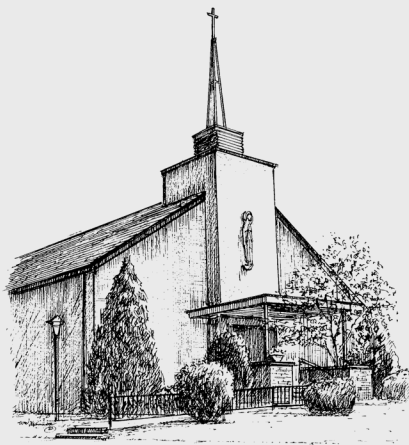

Ecclesiastes reminds us that because God provides for us now and always, we can manage our daily affairs without anxiety. Saint Paul encourages the Colossians to keep thoughts of heaven in everything they do, and Jesus himself asks us to treasure not earthly wealth, but God alone.

Wow! The summer is passing so quickly and soon the school bells will be ringing again. We here at Seven Dolors have begun to prepare for the upcoming Faith Formation year. 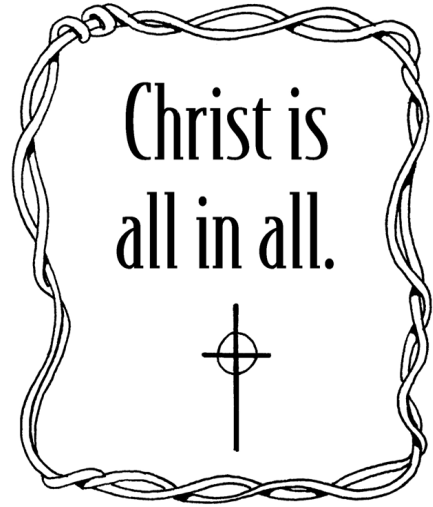
A Bible Study at St. Paul
