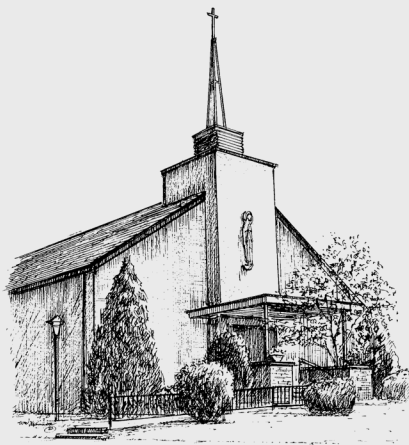

The congregation of the LSOSF then spread to other countries. Today the LSOSF render their services in the East African Countries of Kenya, Uganda, and Tanzania. A few of our sisters are also doing ministry in USA. God continues to bless us with the gift of religious vocations and continued growth and we are grateful. Currently, our institute has 780 professed members serving in the three East African Countries and many young members in the formation program.

Our Mission is to spread the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, following the footsteps of our father St. Francis of Assisi and in the spirit of our Mother Mary Kevin (Servant of God). We are called to love, care, and serve our neighbors particularly women and children, the poor, the marginalized and the needy in our world today. Our ministries include taking care Orphans, care of the street children, the elderly, people with HIV/AIDS, refugees, single mothers, the youth, and people with various disabilities. Some of our sisters provide health care to the poor people in their villages while others render their services in the parishes as social and pastoral workers and as teachers of religion (RCIA and CCD).

Many of our sisters are involved in works of evangelization and pastoral ministry, teaching at all levels. We are now called to redirect more attention to the poor Orphans and street children who have become vulnerable to addictions, abuse and violent behavioral acts emerging in our society.
